



ACHIEVEMENTS OF THE 2017/18 HUNGARIAN PRESIDENCY OF THE VISEGRAD GROUP

#EuropeanVisegrad



European Visegrad included: representing regional interests in EU decision-making (key areas: ensuring the functioning of the four freedoms, post-2020 Multiannual Financial Framework, cohesion and agricultural policy, digitalisation, interior affairs), contribution to the 'future of the EU' debate; political & sectoral cooperation with EU Member States; responsible handling of the migration crisis; justice cooperation.

Main achievements:

- joint V4 & V4+ positions issued to shape EU legislation related to MFF, cohesion, agriculture, energy, transport, social issues, digitalisation, etc.
- V4 Prime Ministers' input to the debate on Europe's future
- strong cooperation with EU Member States (Austria, Bulgaria, Croatia, Romania, Slovenia, Baltic states, United Kingdom, Italy etc.)
- vitalising V4+British relations in preparation for a post-Brexit period
- refocusing the **migration**-related EU discourse on security & border control
- EUR 35 million V4 contribution to border protection efforts in Libya



#RegionalVisegrad

Regional Visegrad included: strengthening cohesion between V4 societies (social events, culture, sport. Visegrad Fund); parliamentary relations; supporting the Western Balkans and the Eastern Partnership; security and defence cooperation; energy, climate and transport infrastructure.

Main achievements:

- official talks on developing high-speed railway connections launched
- strong support to EU enlargement & dialogue with Balkans partners
- Western Balkans Fund's functioning started with V4 assistance
- active V4 Parliamentary dimension
- further deepening defence cooperation; joint military exercises
- V4 energy think tank platform launched, supported by the Visegrad Fund
- international conferences on energy security and gas supply









#DigitalVisegrad



Digital Visegrad included: shaping EU policies based on the principle of raising competitiveness; coordination in economy, labour and finance issues; advancing the digitalisation of economy; fostering V4 and V4+ science, technology and innovation cooperation; developing the regional startup ecosystem; cooperation in agriculture, environment, tax and customs.

Main achievements:

- V4+Israel innovation training program launched
- 'V4 Startup Force' mentoring & mobility program launched
- enhanced dialogue on industry 4.0 and automotive cars
- V4 Smart Platform (aimed at regionally interoperable services) launched
- V4 Startup and Innovation Days & V4+Google Innovation Forum held
- cooperation of development banks, export promotion institutions, post offices (e-commerce) & statistical offices launched





#GlobalVisegrad



Global Visegrad included: building V4+ partnerships with non-European partners; joint V4 responses to global challenges; external promotion of the Visegrad region; cooperation in international development and humanitarian aid with special regard to tackling the root causes of migration.

Main achievements:

- global visibility of the V4 significantly raised
- involving **new global partners** in V4+ consultations (Australia, Central Asia, Pacific Alliance, African Union)
- first-ever V4+Israel and V4+Egypt summit meetings held
- first-ever V4 international development project launched in Kenya
- enhancing V4+USA dialogue
- working closely with Japan and South-Korea
- joint tourism and economic promotion

ABOUT THE VISEGRAD GROUP & ITS HUNGARIAN PRESIDENCY 2017/18

The **Visegrad Group**, named after a Hungarian town that hosted a summit of Hungarian, Czech and Polish kings in 1335, is a contemporary regional cooperation of the **Czech Republic**, **Hungary**, **Poland** and **Slovakia**. Since 1991, the Visegrad countries worked together on their transition to democracy and market economy, as well as a swift EU and NATO integration. After the V4 states' accession to both organisations being completed by 2004, Visegrad became an essential framework of representing joint interests in the EU, launching joint projects, and bringing closer the four societies.

Hungary held the **Presidency of the V4 between 1 July 2017 and 30 June 2018**, with the motto **#V4Connects**. In a historically important period, Hungary's intensive presidency reached its ambitious goals – and sometimes even more.
