

PROTOCOL

of the 25th Meeting
of the International Olympic Hopes Steering Committee
29 November 2018
Bratislava, Slovakia

With respect to the long tradition of mutual cooperation and contacts in sport which were especially enhanced after the Visegrád Conference and with the intention to continue and develop these traditions, the entrusted delegations of the sport organisations and the state administrations of the Hungary, Poland, Czech Republic and Slovakia and have decided to approve the following executive programme of the original protocol:

1. The Olympic Hopes (OH) Competitions of the Visegrád group countries (hereinafter referred as "V4") will be organized in 47 Olympic Hopes events in the year 2019.
2. In the year 2019, the events organization will be undertaken by the following countries in the following sports and sports disciplines:

CALENDAR with HOSTING NATIONS, DATES and VENUES is enclosed to this protocol.

The venues and the dates of the events are to be confirmed by the competent sport federations.

3. Czech Republic is the next Olympic Hopes Competitions coordinator in the year 2019.

All Visegrad countries will appoint a national coordinator and inform other coordinators about address, phone and e-mail address before 15 January 2019.

National coordinators of all Visegrad countries will inform the federations about dates and venues of the competitions before 31 January 2019.

4. It is recommended not to use the title *Olympic Hopes Competitions* for other competitions organised for children and youth.
5. The competitions are open to other invited countries out of the V4 frame.
6. The competitions shall be held in one of the V4 countries. If agreed with all V4 countries, V4 *Olympic Hopes Competitions* can be held in other country.
7. Every sport federation is obliged to organize appropriate competition under following conditions:
 - every foreign participant will cover its subsistence expenses, transportation to the place of competition and insurance;
 - every organizer of the competition will provide accommodation and board not exceeding the value of 50 Euro per person and a day: this limit is applied to participants from V4 countries only; (due to

special circumstances if the cost is higher than 50 Euro per person and the organizer should inform and discuss with other federations before the event);

- the organization costs will be covered by the hosting sport federation.

8. In the regulations the hosting sport federation should clearly declare the number of the team members invited from the V4 countries indicating the number of the competitors, coaches, referees and accompanists. The final condition of the event should be clarified in the rules and regulations and final information of respective OH event.
9. The above information must be sent to the participating sport federations no later than 3 months before the beginning of the competition. The name, e-mail address, phone and fax numbers of the contact and responsible persons will be provided, too.
10. The organising sport federation is obliged to confirm the programme of the competition including the age of competitors and other details and to give all that information to every participating sport federation. If there is any major change of the confirmed date or venue, it must be announced no later than 3 months before the original date. The national coordinator should be informed as soon as possible about competition date and venue changes.
11. The organizers are invited to realize seminars for coaches and other specialists during the competition.
12. Withdrawal of confirmed teams from events should be announced no later than 2 months before the competition.
13. The next meeting of the International Olympic Hopes Steering Committee will be held in Czech Republic in November or December 2019. The date and venue are to be confirmed.
14. The report from the organizers including results shall be sent to the coordinator after the competitions carried out in 2019 no later than one month before the upcoming meeting of the International Olympic Hopes Steering Committee.
